



Year 1 Term 3b Once Upon a Time



Maths

We are learning:

- To find 10 more and 10 less than a number.
- To add and subtract numbers using an empty number line.
- To use language to describe position and direction e.g. full turn, half turn, quarter turn, three quarter turn, forwards, backwards, left, right
- About the place value of numbers to 100
- To recognise coins and notes, and add and subtract amounts of money.
- To read the time on an analogue for o'clock and half past the hour
- To count forwards and backwards in 1's 2's 5's and 10's.

Parents you can help by playing shops with your child using real money. Don't forget Purple Mash and Espresso both have fun maths games for your child to play.

RE

We are learning:

- About Islam
- What does it mean to be a Muslim?

PSHE (Relationship and Health Education)

We are learning:

- To explore different kinds of families
- About what happens when things get lost or change
- About road safety and who helps to keep us safe

Parents talk to your child about how they feel about 'moving' from Year one to Year 2 – are they excited, what are they looking forward to doing. Have they got any questions or concerns?

PE

Athletics

Parents you can help by timing how long it takes to do an activity. e.g. to do 10 star jumps, jog around the park once...

Science

We are learning:

- About materials. We will be using our senses to explore different materials and will be sorting them into groups. E.g. waterproof or absorbent. We will be thinking why different materials are chosen for different objects and carrying out an investigation to find out which material will be best for Cinderella's mop.

Parents you can help by talking to your child about the material objects are made from e.g. their jumper, the kitchen table, their toys etc. Ask them why they think those materials have been used – why isn't a power ranger made from paper? Why isn't my jumper made from glass? Look at:

Literacy

We are learning:

- About traditional tales – we will be reading, re-telling and role playing, The three little pigs and Little red Riding Hood. We will be re-telling some of these stories using actions and story language.
- To write a recount using past tense words such as walked, looked, saw
- About adding the prefix **un** (unhappy, untidy, unkind, unhealthy...)
- About the adding suffix **er** (bigger, longer, weaker, stronger...)

Parents you can help by reading other traditional tales to your child.

You can also talk to your child about different fairy stories, discussing which is your favourite and why.

DT

We are learning:

- Design, make and evaluate a puppet using joining methods such as sewing and gluing.
- Select from and use a range of tools and equipment to perform practical tasks e.g. cutting, joining and finishing.

ICT

We are learning:

- To draw a traditional tale scene.
- To type a sentence using capital letters, full stops and finger spaces.

Parents you can help by practising these skills on a computer.

We are learning:

- To program a robot.

Parents you can help by talking about left and right turns when you are walking to school.
