We are learning:

- To join our handwriting.

Maths

We are learning to:

- Estimate, compare and measure length, weight and capacity.
- Use a ruler to measure and draw lines in cms.
- Understand and use units of time, e.g. seconds, minutes.
- Use knowledge of number facts to estimate and check answers.
- Solve problems involving addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.
